Roadworks and diversions affecting Go North East buses

Service 9 at Truro Avenue in Murton from 23 September and 30 April

Works are in place at Truro Avenue in Murton until the end of April, between 7.30am and 5pm.

Service 9 will run normal route to Mann Crescent then will divert left at the cream houses to Treen Crescent and Tegoney Avenue and right to normal route at Penryn Avenue.

Buses will be unable to serve stops on Truro Avenue and Bude Square. There will be a temporary stop approximately half way down Tegoney Avenue.

Service 74 at Ponteland from 2 March until 4 September

Callerton Lane will be closed to Northbound traffic from Monday 2 March for up to 6 months. Service 74 will be diverted for the duration of the works.

Service 74 will be unable to serve Northbound bus stops on Callerton Lane between Mayfair Gardens and Middle Drive. Please use stops on the opposite side of the road of Darras Road, Eastern Way and Callerton Lane for buses towards Hexham.

Service X71 at Burnopfield from 23 until 27 March

The B6310 will be closed for tree felling work between 8am and 5pm for 5 days from Monday 23 until Friday 27 March.

During these times, service X71 will be unable to serve stops on Burnopfield Front Street. Buses will serve the bus stop at Medomsley Church and resume normal route at Leazes Church. Customers from Manor Road should use the bus stop at Medomsley Church.

Services 1, 1A and 1B at Cullercoats from 23 March until 3 April

There will be three way temporary lights at the junction of Beverley Terrace and Marden Avenue from Monday 23 March until Friday 3 April.

Coaster buses will be unable to stop at the bus stop on Marden Avenue near Beverley Villas and unfortunately there isn't a suitable place for a replacement stop. Please join us at the next stop on Marden Avenue.

Services 16 and X70 at Dipton between 6 and 16 April

Dipton Front Street will be closed from 9am until 3pm from Monday 6 until Thursday 9 April and from Tuesday 15 until Wednesday 16 April for resurfacing.

Buses will be unable to operate between Dipton Red Lion and High Stables due to essential maintenance work being carried out by Durham County Council.

Between 9am and 3pm from Monday 6 April until Thursday 9 April and from Tuesday 14 April to Wednesday 15 April buses will operate on diversion between Dipton and Brooms Road Ends.

You'll be able to board diverted services 16 and X70 at the bus stops on Co-Operative Terrace.

Services 2, 2A, 8A, 78 and 78A at Chester Road in Sunderland from 4 until 7 April

Chester Road will be closed from 8am on Saturday 4 April until Tuesday 7 April.

Buses towards Sunderland will be unable to serve bus stops on Chester Road between Sevenoaks Drive and Greenwood Road during these times while resurfacing works are carried out.

Services 2, 2A, 8A, 78 and 78A will operate via Sevenoaks Drive, Gartland Road & Greenwood Road serving all stops on the diversion route.

Services 2, 2A, 8A, 78 and 78A at Chester Road in Sunderland on 8 and 9 April

Chester Road will be closed westbound from 9am on Wednesday 8 April and all day on Thursday 9 April.

Buses towards Shiney Row will be unable to serve bus stops on Chester Road between Greenwood Road and Sevenoaks Drive during these times while resurfacing works are carried out.

Buses will turn left from Chester Road onto Greenwood Road and operate along Gartland Road and Sevenoaks Drive, serving all stops on the diversion route.

Services 2, 2A, 8A, 78 and 78A at Chester Road in Sunderland on 14 April

Chester Road will be closed westbound from 9am until midnight on Tuesday 14 April.

Buses towards Shiney Row will be unable to serve bus stops on Chester Road between Greenwood Road and Sevenoaks Drive during these times while resurfacing works are carried out.

Buses will turn left from Chester Road onto Greenwood Road and operate along Gartland Road and Sevenoaks Drive, serving all stops on the diversion route.
