Service changes from 1 September 2019

From 1 September, there will be some minor changes to a small number of services.

Service 19

- On a weekday, the journeys at 5.06pm and 5.26pm from Northumberland Park to North Shields will be merged into one journey at 5.16pm.

- To avoid congestion on Market Street in Newcastle City Centre, buses will now terminate at Market Street East. They will continue to pick up from Market Street outside of the Coop store, and you will now also be able to board the bus at Market Street East.
